Appropriate Homework Modification

Dear Parents,

In order to determine appropriate modification levels within your child's homework, for the next two weeks your child's teacher and the Administrator will be determining a baseline of your child's homework (amount of homework and unfinished class-work) they have. The teachers understand that in this two-week period, no modifications will be given to their homework. In such, we are looking for a baseline of what your child can complete in our school's designated homework guideline time for your child's grade level.

I am asking that you help your child to become responsible to the prioritized items on their homework assignments. These "Priority numbers" with number 1 to be done first, number 2 to be done second, etc... allows the student and parent to know what homework needs to be done first, as all teachers will be expecting these to be done as a priority.

In the homework guidelines, each grade has a designated homework policy time. Please have your child keep accountable to this time by doing the "Priority Numbered" homework as well as their reading for their book reports (suggested 10-15 minutes), practice of their Bible Memory verse, and studying for their spelling words.

If they do not finish their homework, a signature must be placed on their homework paper in order for them to not be delinquent, graded down, or placed on detention. Any incomplete homework without a signature from their parent or guardian will give them the consequences of incomplete homework for their grade.

The two-week period will determine appropriate homework levels for your child. You will be informed of what their classroom teacher and the Administrator determines as appropriate modifications if any, for their homework.
